

## Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering (CME)

The undergraduate program in Chemical Engineering offers Fall admission to students interested in obtaining a B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering. All interested students must:

1. Meet UTSA's College of Engineering admission requirements, and
2. Have credit for MAT 1214 Calculus I OR have completed all necessary prerequisites to enroll in MAT 1214 Calculus I (through a mathematics placement test taken during orientation, or credit for MAT 1093 Pre-calculus or an equivalent).
3. Have credit for CHE 1103 General Chemistry I OR have completed all necessary prerequisites to enroll in CHE 1103 General Chemistry I (through a Chemistry Placement Examination taken during orientation, or a grade of "C-" or better in CHE 1073 Basic Chemistry or an equivalent).

In addition, freshman students considering Fall admission to the Chemical Engineering program **must submit the following supplemental documents by end of July.**

1. High school transcript and/or college transcripts (copies will suffice); and
2. Declaration of intent to be considered as a Chemical Engineering Major (see below)

Admission status will be made known to the students by August 15. **Note that admissions to the program will be competitive and meeting the aforementioned requirements does not guarantee admission to the program. Admission will be restricted only to the most qualified applicants.** Students accepted to the CME program but fail to register for CHE 1103 and MAT 1214 Calculus I or higher in the first Fall semester after admission will have to reapply for program admission. Note that reapplication does not guarantee admission to the program. All CME students must also keep in mind that they are required to maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better for their duration in the program. Students whose GPA falls below 2.5 will be dismissed from the program. Students with GPA 2.5-3.0 will be issued a warning. **See Program Description for additional information on admission, descriptions of courses, and requirements for good academic standing.**
