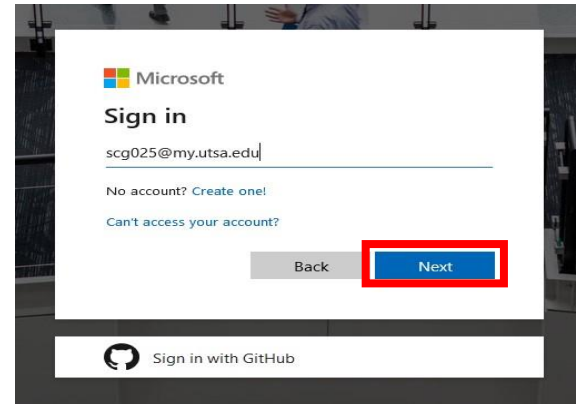
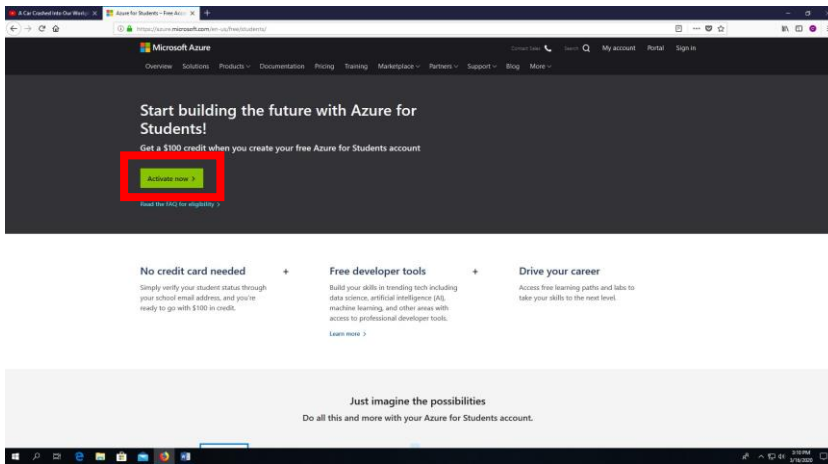


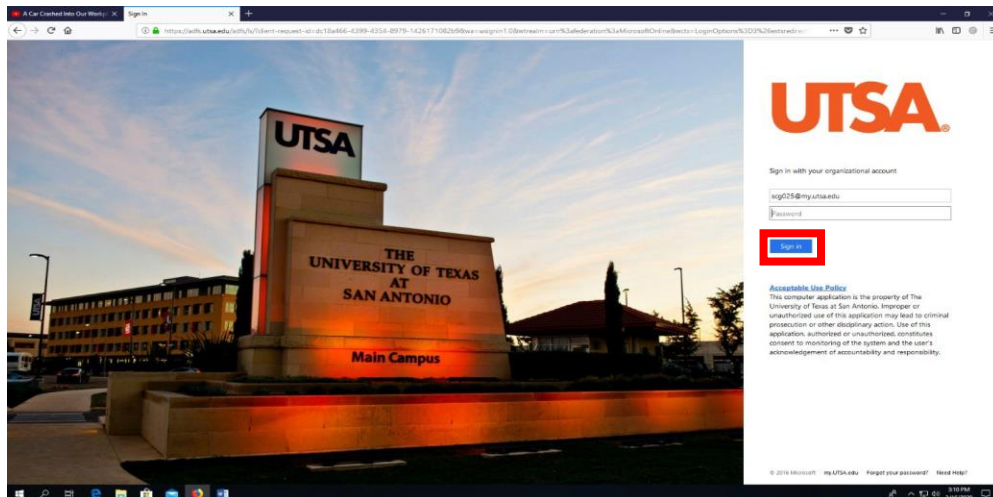
Install for Microsoft Project

The steps to check install Project from Microsoft Azure for Students

- 1) Go to our website: <https://azure.microsoft.com/en-us/free/students/>
- 2) When the Microsoft Azure webpage comes up go to the right corner and **CLICK** the **Activate Now** button. When A Sign In window will come up and you will type your UTSA email address <abc123>@my.utsa.edu and **CLICK** the button **Next**



- 3) The UTSA login page will come up and you will type your **Password** that is linked to this email. **Click** the **Sign In** button



- 4) After a successful login fill out the information for **Identity Verification by phone** box and choose the method to verify it is you.

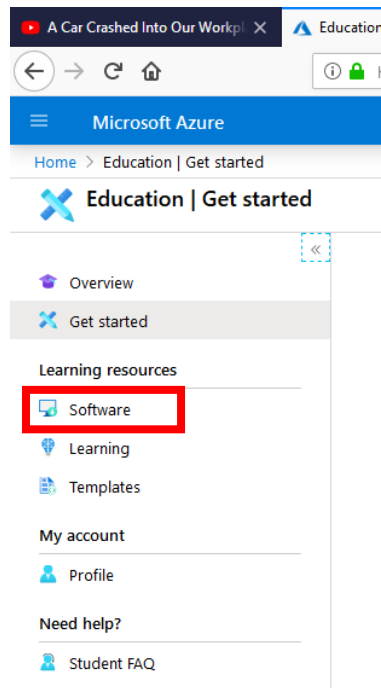

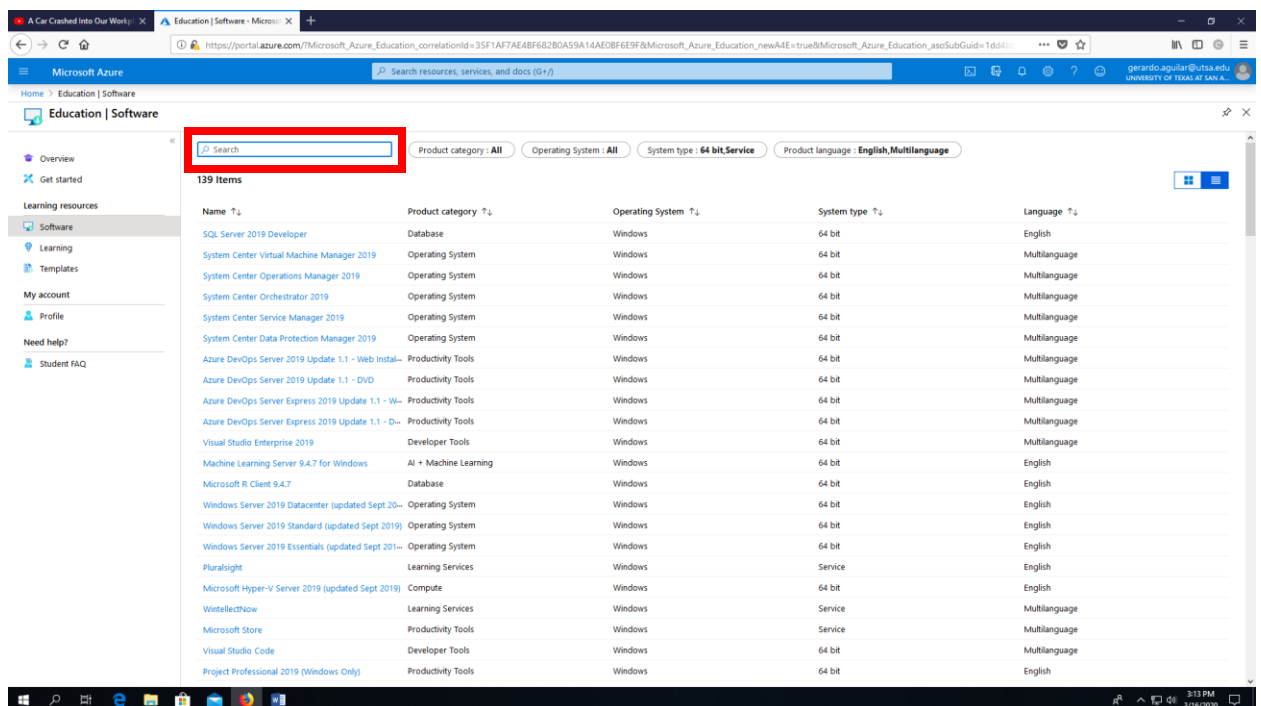

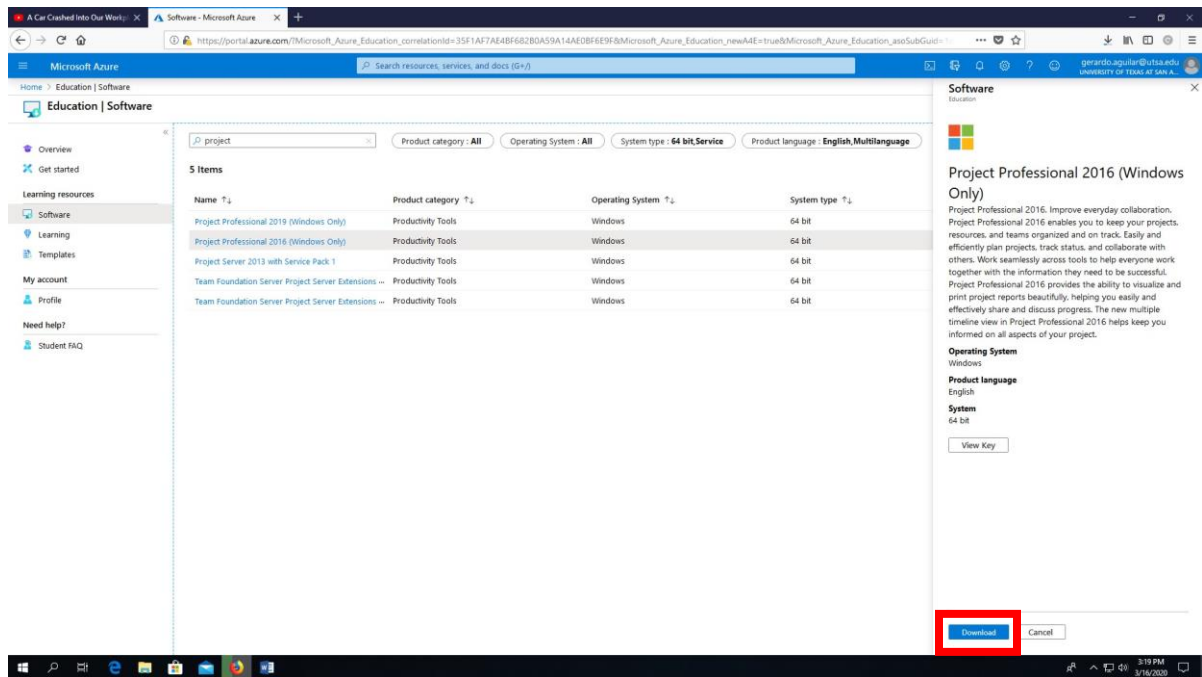
- 6) A welcome page will pop up for Microsoft Azure and on the left side tab **click** on the **Software** button.



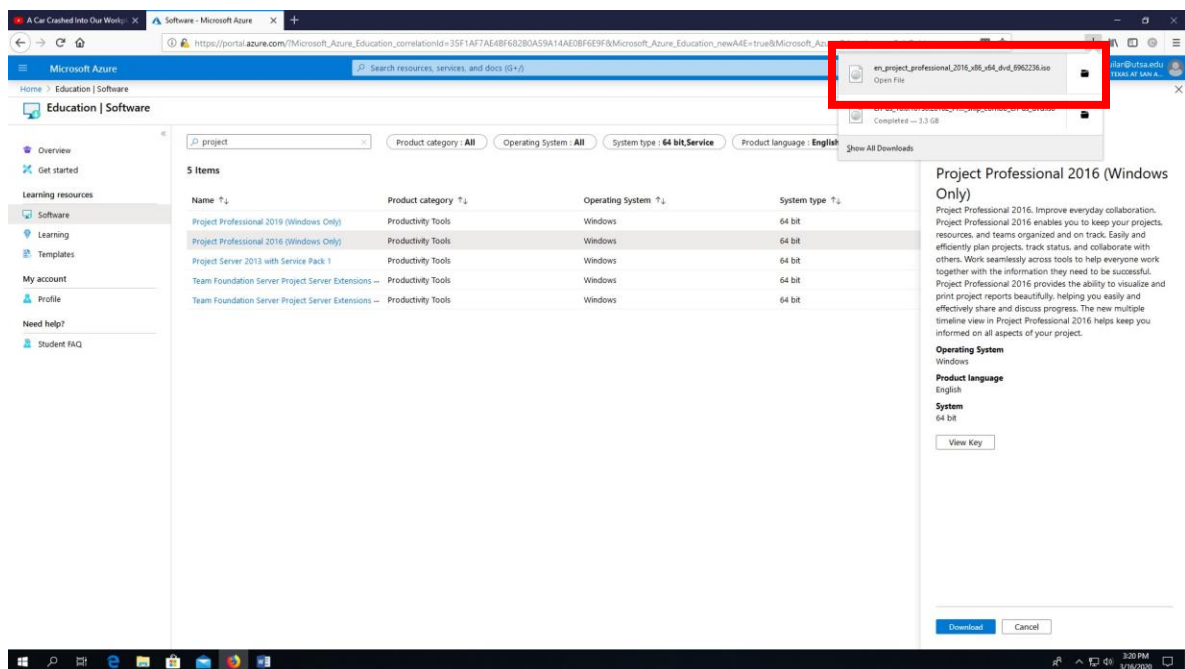
- 7) A software list will appear and in the search type **Project**.



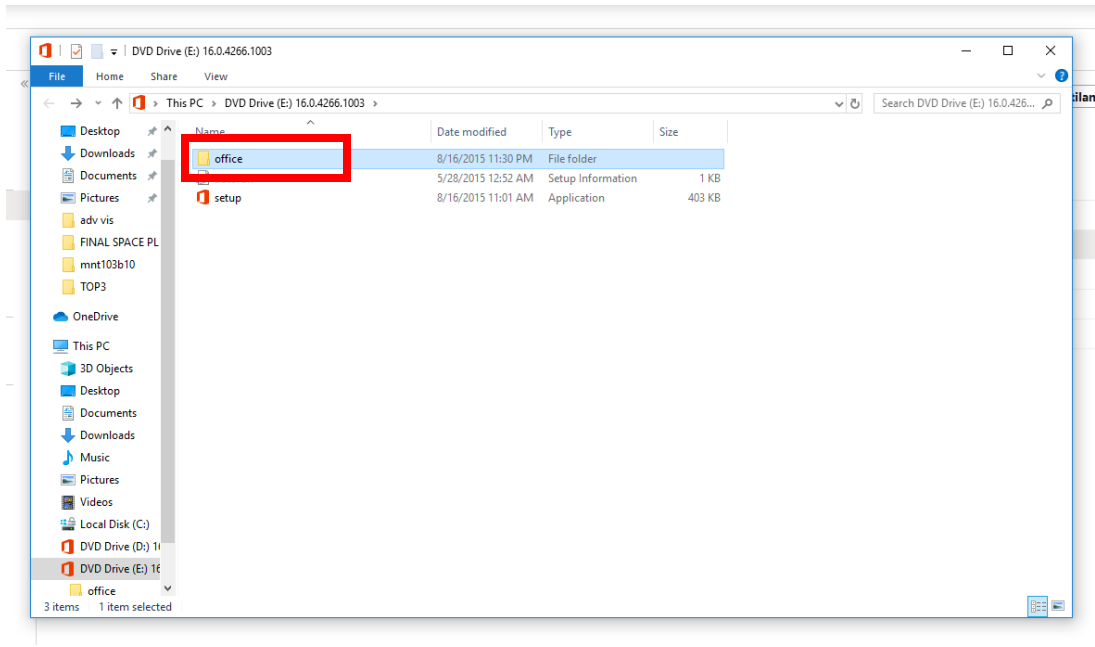
- 8) The results will come up and this is where you will choose the **Project** you would like to install. Once you have selected the Project version you wish to install on the bottom **click** the **Download** button.



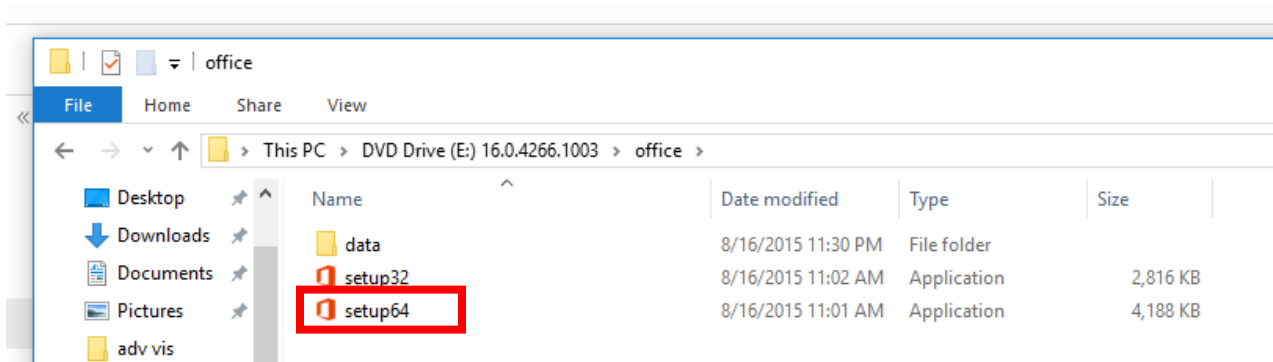
- 9) Once the download has finished **click** on the star to Open the Downloads and select the file to **Open** it.



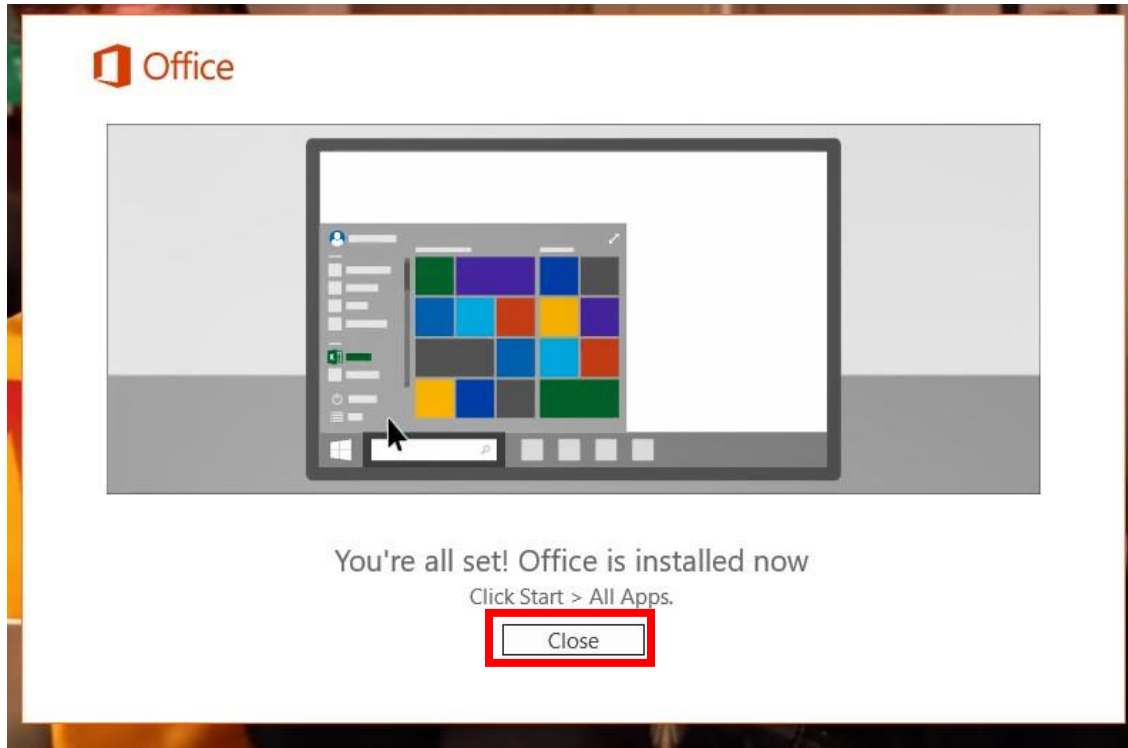
10) The file explorer will come up with the contents that were downloaded. **Double-Click** the **Office** folder.



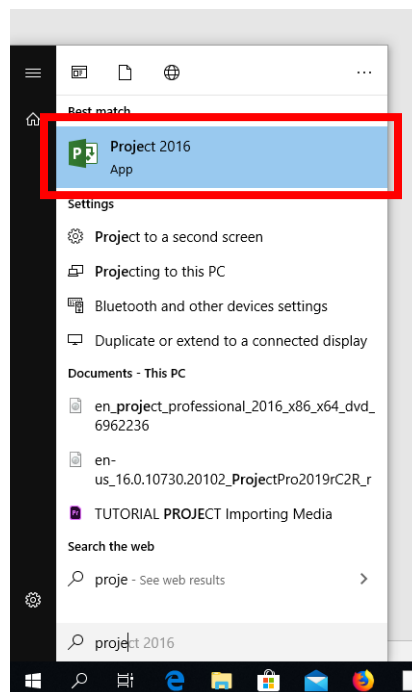
11) In this folder you will find the applications to start the install. **Double-Click** the application **setup64**.
