

## College Honors Program

The Margie and Bill Klesse College of Engineering and Integrated Design designates certain of its outstanding students as honors students. College Honors students have the opportunity for advanced study under close supervision of faculty and will receive the notation of “College Honors” on their transcripts after graduation. To be eligible for the program, students must have a minimum overall grade-point average of 3.25 at UTSA and a minimum grade-point average of 3.25 in courses in their major at UTSA. In order to receive the designation, a student must:

- Have a supervising committee of two College faculty, one serving as the supervising professor
- Enroll in EGR 4993 Honors Research in the final two semesters at UTSA
- Complete a research project and write an honors thesis
- Obtain the approvals of his/her supervising committee, faculty in the department, the Department or School Chair, and the Associate Dean.
